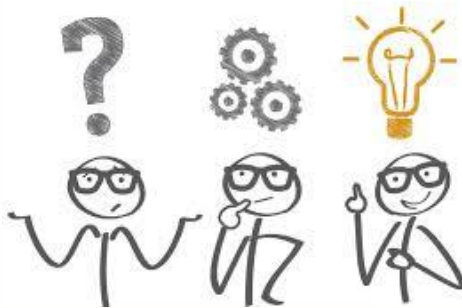

# More

Countable nouns


✓ There are more people in the academy this year.

Uncountable nouns

✓ We received more money as a bonus this season.

Verbs

✓ I do more at home than what my sister does.



It is used the same in all statements





# Less

It is used only in some statements

## Uncountable nouns

✓ You are working more time this year, so you have **less time** for your family.

✓ My mother has **less patience** than my dad.

## Verbs

✓ Victoria **talks less** than I do in a reunion.

✓ Pedro **moves less** when he plays video games.





# Fewer

It is used only for countable nouns

Countable nouns

✓ I know that there are **fewer cars** in La Merced because there are fewer paved roads.



✓ My house has **fewer bathrooms** than yours, in fact my house has only one.

✓ I don't have **fewer free minutes** than you do, we work almost the same time.



It is not very common in  
conversations

**Even though it is not commonly used in conversations, WE HAVE TO USE IT for countable nouns.**

- Chile has fewer immigrants than Perú has.
- There are fewer bananas in the basket than in the bag.
- Every minute passes, we have fewer chances to win the game.
